FSP

While your FTC has their own approved syllabuses, in order to obtain American Winds', associate degree, you will train on American Winds' syllabus. In order to access the syllabus on FSP, there is a fee of \$40.

RENTERS INSURANCE

American Winds, and therefore your Flight Training Center, requires all students to obtain at-least \$80,000 in non-owned aircraft for the duration of flight training. A copy of your obtained policy must be sent to admissions@americanwinds.edu

ADDITIONAL FEES

Initial fees at the time on enrollment include the first syllabus fee, a registration fee of \$125 and the first lab fee of \$500.
