



Unmanned Aerial Systems Drone Pilot Certificate Course

This class will prepare you on all aspects required to undertake the sUAS FAA Knowledge Exam for commercial drone operations.

Topics included in the class are:

- FAA regulations
- Aeromedical factors
- Aeronautical decision making
- Airport operations
- Aviation weather
- Aviation hazards
- Airworthiness



Once completed, you will be prepared to take the FAA Knowledge Test at a CATS testing facility. Upon satisfactory completion of the exam, you will be awarded a remote pilot operators certificate by the FAA.

The Instructors from Upper Limit Aviation have condensed the class to 40 hours (the normal class is 48 classroom hours over 16 nights) with the FAA Certification Test at the end.

Since the course has been condensed and the amount of information being put out it is recommended that participants arrive on time for the class and plan on attending the entire 40-hour block.

Cost for the Course is **\$400.00 Payable to Upper Limit Aviation (801) 596-7722**

There is also a \$150.00 Testing fee Payable to the FAA at the end of the course

Payment to Upper Limit Aviation must be made by August 31st to guarantee a spot in the class.
